



Total Market for Legal Services (\$B)




US Outside Counsel Market






US Market for Litigation, by Spending and Number of Matters 2011–2021

Corporate Counsel Use at Least 35 Law Firms


Question: About how many outside law firms do you work with today?




New Corporate Counsel Substantially Less Happy with Outside Counsel








